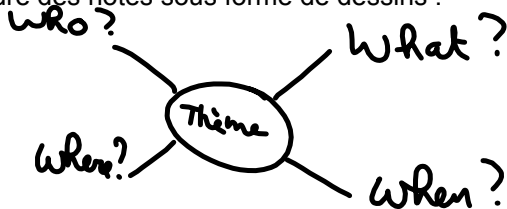


Compréhension Orale

Présentation :

Le brouillon :

- ne prendre en note que les mots-clés --> pas de phrases!
- définir un code couleur (par thèmes, par personnages)
- prendre des notes sous forme de dessins :



- changer de couleur en fonction des infos +/- précises.

La copie :

- ne surtout pas laisser de blancs! Si vous ne savez pas, tant pis!
- aérer la présentation
- ne surtout pas mélanger l'anglais et le français.

Quelques "trucs" pour apprendre à écouter :

- réfléchir au vocabulaire qui porte sur le thème
- quand j'entends un mot, je pense au champ lexical associé.
- je me sers de TOUT l'enregistrement pour reconstituer le sens de l'enregistrement.
- j'essaie de déduire le sens d'après certains mots, les bruitages, l'intonation de la voix qui traduit les émotions.

Correction CO (A2 information / B1 information)

Alice (0.25) is visiting a flat. She meets Edward (0.25) who lives in the flatshare. Karl (0.25) is absent : he had an important appointment today(+1).

Edward asks Alice if she would like a cup of tea (0.5).

There are 5 flatmates (0.25) in the flat : Amanda (0.25) who is Australian (0.25), Eileen (+1) who is Irish (0.5), Karl (0.25), Marcello (0.25) who is Italian and Edward.

There are 6 bedrooms (0.25) in the flat : 5 are upstairs (0.5) and one is downstairs (0.5). Everybody has their own room (1).

Edward shows the living-room (0.25) and the kitchen (0.25) to Alice. There are also 2 bathrooms (0.5).

Alice would like to see her room (0.5). It is downstairs (0.25). It is furnished. (1) The bed (0.25) and the mattress (+2) are new (0.5).

There is also a bow window (+2).

The rent is £250 (0.5) per month (0.5) + £50 for water and electricity (0.5).

The flatmates don't often invite guests (1) and rarely organise parties (1). Alice thought Italians loved parties! (1) but Marcello is not outgoing (+1) and he gets up at 5am every day (0.5).

Alice meets (0.25) Amanda, the Australian flatmate (0.25). She likes (0.25) the flat. It looks comfortable (0.25).

There is a piano in the flat (0.25). Alice thinks it is Karl's, but he doesn't play any instruments (0.5). It is Eileen's (0.5). She plays every day between 4 and 5 pm (1).

Alice plays the electric guitar (0.5). She must practise every day (1). She wants to be a rock star! (1).
