

History and Festa



Valletta is the capital city of Malta. Located in the south east of the island. Valletta's 16th century buildings were constructed by the Knights Hospitaller. The city is Baroque in character, with elements of Mannerist, Neo-Classical and Modern architecture. The city was officially recognised as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1980.



Malta officially known as the Republic of Malta, is a Southern European island country consisting of an archipelago in the Mediterranean Sea. With a population of about 475,000 over an area of 316 km2. The official languages are Maltese and English.

Feast days in the Maltese Islands are enjoyed by locals and tourists alike. However, the most important events for the Maltese people are definitely the village festas where each town or village celebrates its own patron saint. The festa season in Malta takes place from the end of May till September.
