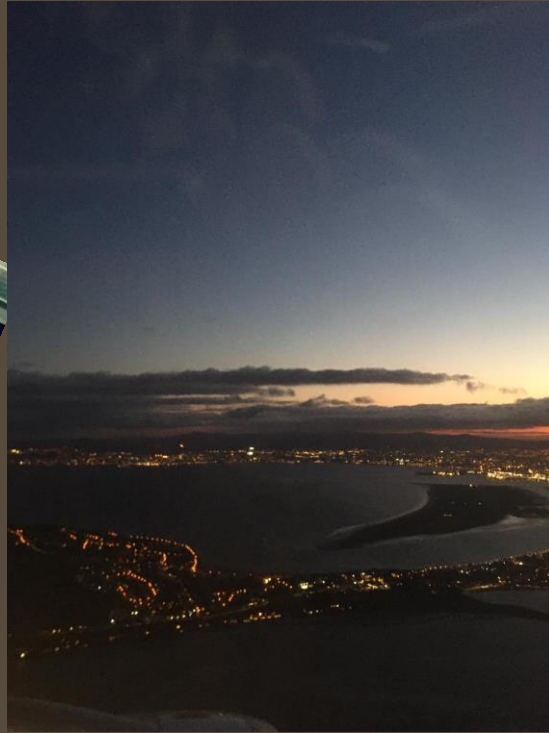

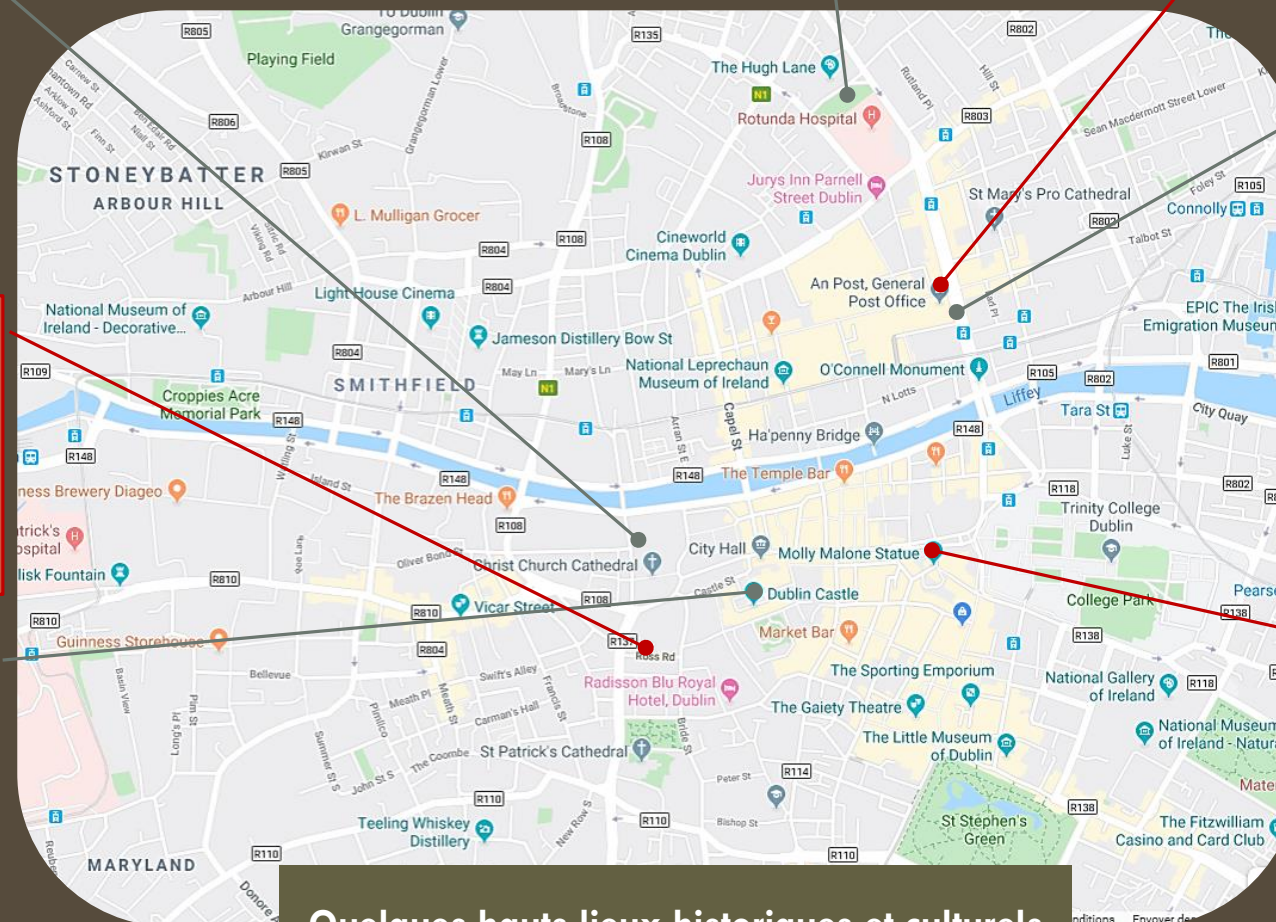

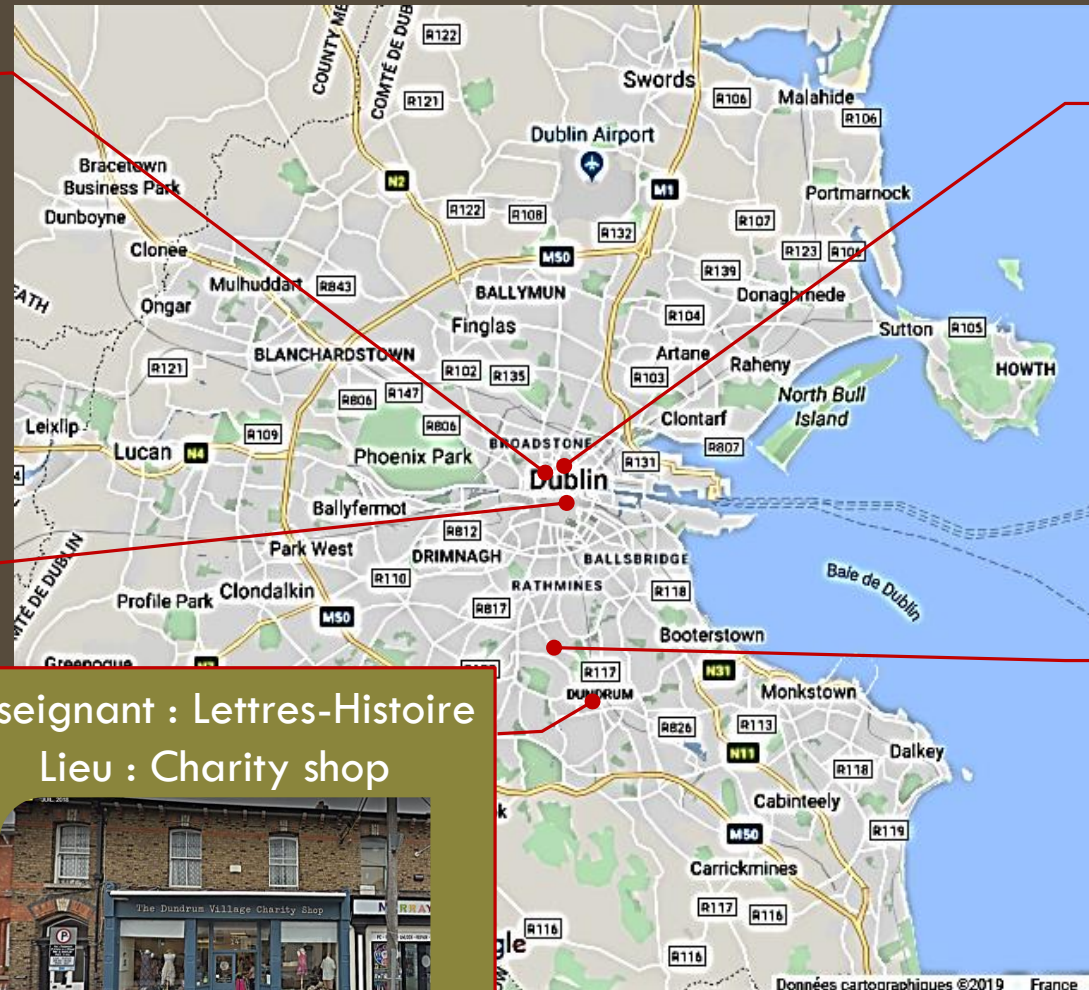

MALT FORKS AND SHOVELS

Maltsters required great skill to ensure all of the barley grains were evenly germinated. After steeping the barley in water, the grains were then drained and spread on the Malthouse floor. Tools such as these forks and shovels were used to spread and turn the grains in order to aid germination. This constant turning took between five and seven days before germination was complete.

INGREDIENTS

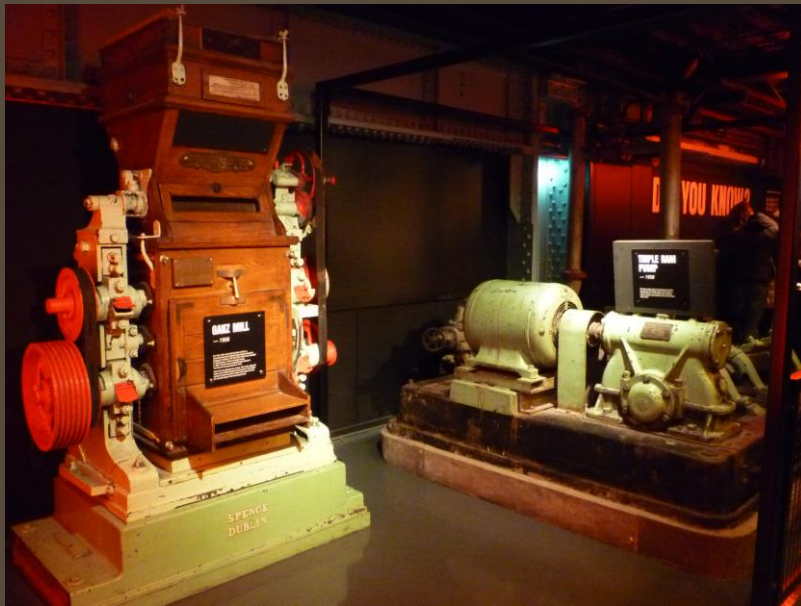
HOPS

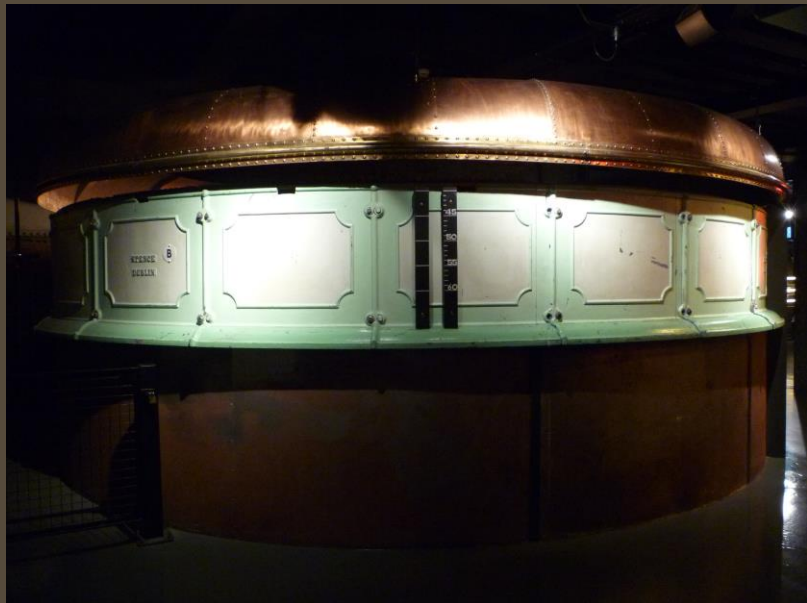
WATER

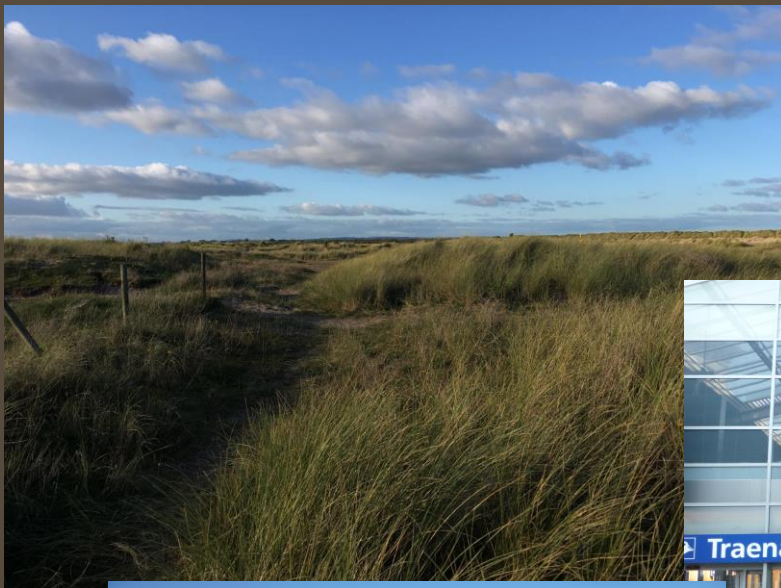
