

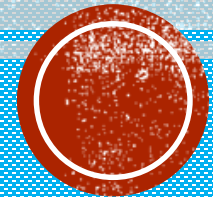
SIGHTS IN BELFAST

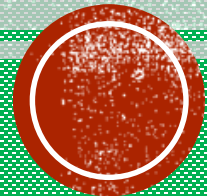

- visit prison cells

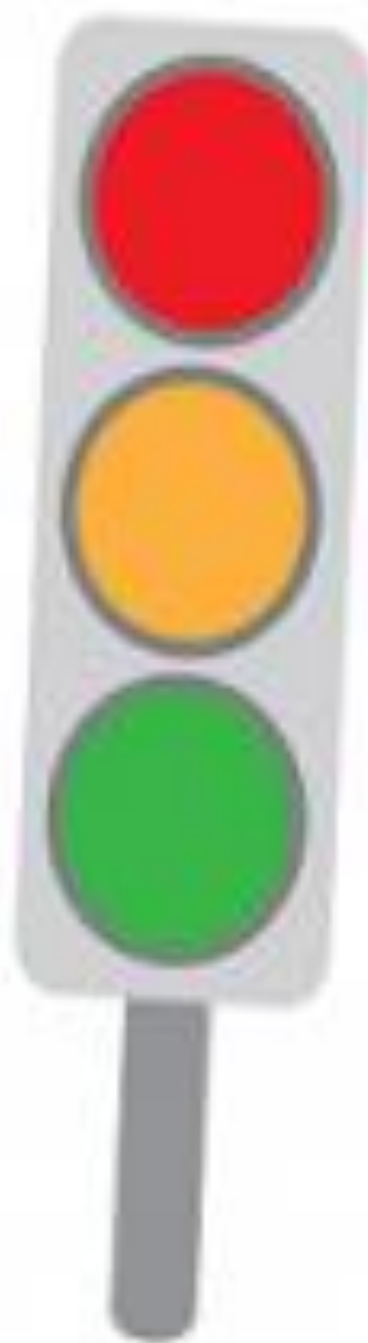
A few things before you get started:

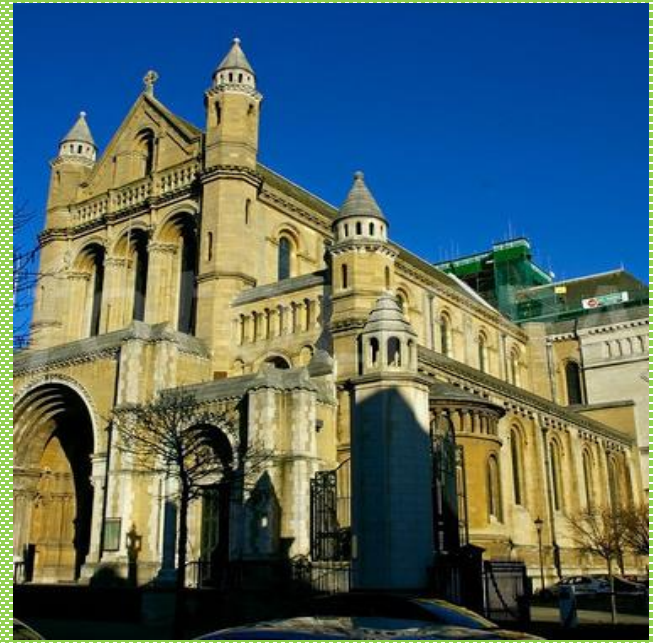

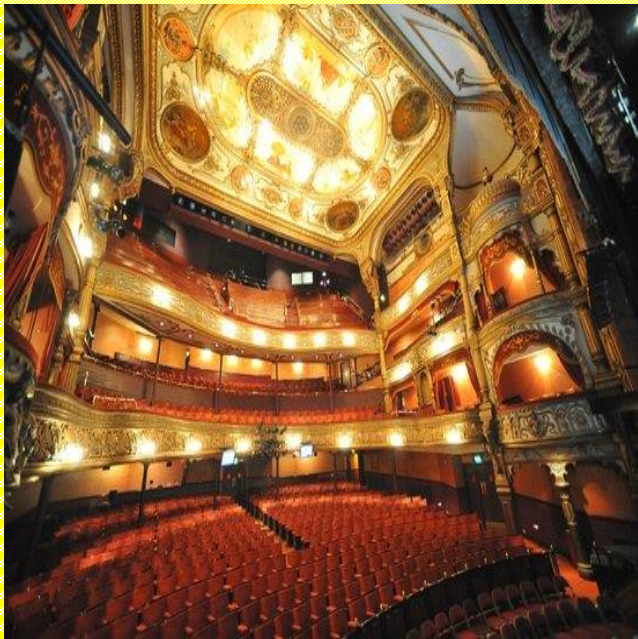
