	<p>.....</p> <p align="center">Kill or injure with or as if with poison.</p>
	<p align="center"><i>(past simple / past participle : hanged)</i></p> <p align="center">Put to death by suspending by the neck from a gallows, gibbet, yardarm, or the like.</p> <p>.....</p>
	<p>.....</p> <p align="center">Cut off the head of; kill or execute by decapitation.</p>
	<p>.....</p> <p align="center">Kill by submerging underwater or other liquid.</p>
	<p>.....</p> <p align="center">Hit,wound,damage,kill,or destroy with a missile discharged from a weapon.</p>
	<p>.....</p> <p align="center">Thrust with or as if with a knife or other pointed weapon (stab at an attacker.)</p>
