It's ... o'clock.

1. What's the time ?

It's five o'clock in the morning. = It's five a.m..

It's five o'clock in the evening. = It's five p.m..

2. What's the time ?

It's ten o'clock in the morning. = It's ten a.m..

It's ten o'clock in the evening. = It's ten p.m.

3. What's the time ?

It's twelve o'clock. It's noon = It's midday.

It's twelve o'clock in the morning. = It's midnight.

4. What's the time ?

It's two o'clock in the morning. It's two a.m.

It's two o'clock in the afternoon. = It's two p.m..
