**It's seven o'clock in the morning. = It's 7 : 00 a.m..**

**It's seven o'clock in the evening. = It's 7 : 00 p.m..**

2. **It's three o'clock.** It's three o'clock in the morning. = It's 3 : 00 a.m..  
It's three o'clock in the afternoon. = It's 3 : 00 p.m..
3. **It's ten o'clock.** It's ten o'clock in the morning. = It's 10 : 00 a.m..  
It's ten o'clock in the evening. = It's 10 : 00 p.m..
4. **It's six o'clock.** It's six o'clock in the morning. = It's 6 : 00 a.m..  
It's six o'clock in the evening. = It's 6 : 00 p.m..
5. **It's one o'clock.** It's one o'clock in the morning. = It's 1 : 00 a.m..  
It's one o'clock in the afternoon. = It's 1 : 00 p.m..
6. **It's twelve o'clock.** It's noon. = It's midday.  
It's midnight.
