ASPERGER SYNDROME




t is in 1944, that an Austria paediatrician, Hans Asperger, observed 4 children who had difficulty integrating socially. They had normal intelligence but lacked non verbal communication skills, failed to demonstrate emphaty towards their peers and were physically clumsy.

Asperger syndrome is a developmental disorder characterized by significant difficulties in social interaction and nonverbal communication, along with restricted and repetitive patterns of behavior and interests. It is an autism spectrum disorder and differs from other disorders by relatively normal language and intelligence. Although not required for diagnosis, physical clumsiness and unusual use of language are common. Symptoms usually begin before two years old and can last for a person's entire life.




We had the chance to meet Christopher, a fifteen-year-old boy who has asperger syndrome.
