Probability in the present

<u>Adverb & verb in the present</u>	
No doubt, certainly, maybe, obviously...	No doubt he feels happy.

Your turn :

<u>S + modal + BV</u>	
Must, may, might, could	He must feel very happy.

Wishes /future

Want, wish + TO +BV	He wants to start a new life. He wishes to start a new life.
S + wish + preterit modal	He wishes he could start a new life. He wishes he were rich.

Probability in the past

<u>Adverb & verb in the past</u>	
No doubt, certainly, maybe, obviously...	No doubt he left his homeland.

<u>S + modal + have + pp</u>	
Must, may, might, could	He must have left his homeland.

Regrets/past

S + wish + pluperfect = had + ppassé	He wishes he had not left his native land. (If only he had not left his native land)
