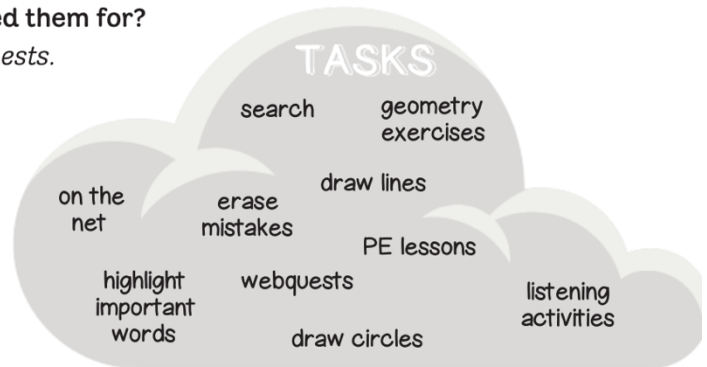
Pour exprimer le but

To + BV
Robots are used to operate on people.

2. Relis la leçon sur 'want + to' et fais l'exercice

Pour exprimer la volonté

Want + to + BV

Si j'exerce ma volonté sur une personne, celle-ci est exprimée par un complément du verbe *want*.

Want	+	someone	+	to	+	BV
		<i>(pronom complément)</i>				
		└──────────────────┘				└──────────┘
		la personne à qui je veux faire faire quelque chose				ce que je veux lui faire faire

I want to have fun.
I want my robot to cook delicious meals, I want it to obey my orders.

• You are writing a video game programme. Four people are locked in a room and they need to escape.

Write what you want them to do to be allowed to get out.

Eg: I want... to + V...

3. Relis la leçon sur 'will + BV' et fais l'exercice

Will + BV

(forme contractée si **le sujet est un pronom** :
'll + BV)

Will est un auxiliaire, il permet donc de former

- des négations : **Won't + BV**
- des interrogations : **Will + sujet + BV?**

⚠ La capacité dans le futur s'exprime avec **Will be able to + BV**

a. Sort the predictions into two categories: "a bright future" or "a depressing future".
 = Classe les prévisions suivantes en deux catégories: « a bright future » (un avenir radieux) ou « a depressing future » (un avenir déprimant).

- humans – finally live in peace

4. Relis la leçon sur 'would' et fais l'exercice

Would est le prétérit de **will**

Il permet d'exprimer une **supposition irréaliste**.

Il s'utilise avec **if + prétérit (si + prétérit)**.

Ex : If I had a robot, it would carry my bag.

→ *Si j'avais un robot, il porterait mon sac.*



Imagine what would/wouldn't happen, what could/couldn't happen, if teachers were replaced by robots.

→ *Imagine ce qui pourrait arriver ou ne pas arriver si les professeurs étaient remplacés par des robots.*

If teachers were replaced by robots, we ...

– Have virtual lessons at home – sleep longer in the morning – use tablets only

– No longer use paper and pen – not/see our friends at school – Have fun?
