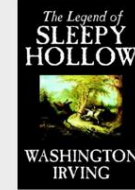

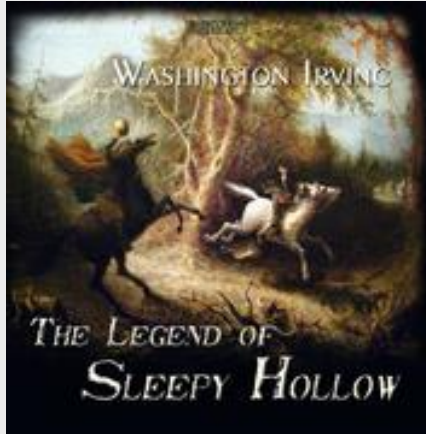

Relève les groupes nominaux (adjectif + nom) qui peuvent t'aider à déterminer l'atmosphère.

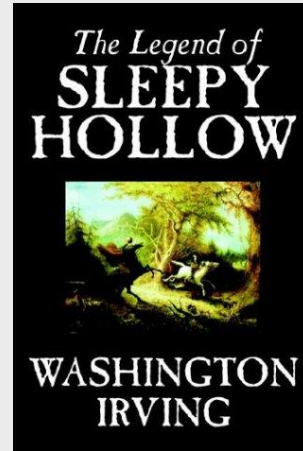

The dominant spirit, however, that haunts this enchanted region, [...] is the apparition of a figure on horseback without a head. His haunts are not confined to the valley, but extend at times to the adjacent roads, and especially to the vicinity of a church at no great distance. Indeed, [...] the body of the trooper having been buried in the churchyard; the ghost rides forth to the scene of battle in nightly quest of his head [...]. Such is the general purport of this legendary superstition, which has furnished materials for many a wild story in that region of shadows; and the spectre is known, at all the country firesides, by the name of the Headless Horseman of Sleepy Hollow.
