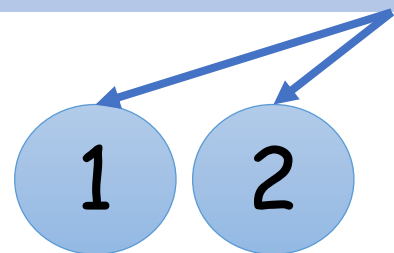

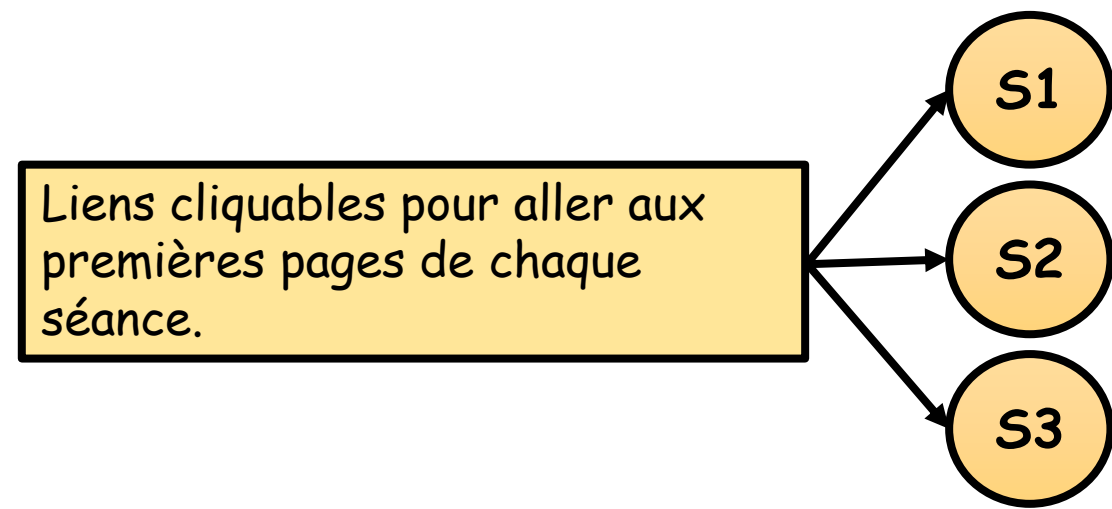

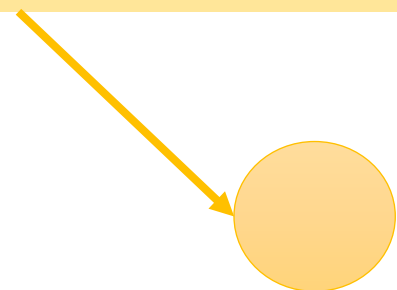

The scene **takes place** in the USA.

In the foreground, two men **are burying** something. Maybe it is **a time capsule**. There is a **round plaque** on the right with dates on it.

An official event seems to be taking place. Indeed, American flags are **displayed** and people are **well-dressed**. Moreover, there is a blue, white and red **ribbon** ready to be cut.

The time capsule is going to **be buried** and someone **will** probably **cut** the ribbon. It **may be** a **ceremony dedicated** to the time capsule or **meant** to **inaugurate** a new building.

Correction



In the video, the scene takes place in an American classroom. The children are quite young so we **can suppose** that it is a primary school.

The scene in the video **must have happened** before the one in the picture. Indeed, the teacher talks about a time capsule project and an upcoming **dedication ceremony**. The pupils **are even asked** to make drawings that **will be enclosed** in the time capsule that **can be seen** in the picture as well as in the video.

Since the teacher mentions « our official opening day », the ceremony **is meant** to inaugurate the school. She adds that the ceremony **will be closed** with the burial of the time capsule, which indicates that the scene in the picture happens at the end of the ceremony.

This event **is dedicated** to someone or something. It suggests that the ceremony probably **honors** a **famous** person or a famous event.

FACT SHEET: TIME CAPSULES

► What is a time capsule?

It is a sealed container that is filled with objects from a particular time, so that people in the future will know what life was like then.

► Where are they stored?

Sometimes time capsules are buried underground, with a plaque that marks the spot. Currently, four time capsules are even "buried" in space!

► What to put in a time capsule

- Pictures.
- Letters. Write a letter to yourself. Ask your parent and friends to write you letters.
- Lists. Write lists of what you love or hate, of your best friends...
- An outgrown but favourite outfit or pair of shoes.
- A calendar of your year. Meetings with friends, parties and vacations can be interesting years later!
- Labels or packaging of your favourite food (like candy wrappers), price tags...

Event: the World's Fair in New York
Contents: everyday items such as a can opener, a light bulb, a dollar bill, a Mickey Mouse child's cup, seeds¹ and the Holy Bible.

Place of burial: New York

Opening date: 6939



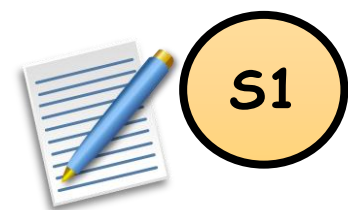
■ 2012: the Jubilee time capsule

Event: 60th Anniversary of Queen Elizabeth II's reign.

Contents: photographs, texts, film and audio recordings telling the stories of over 37,000 people from 54 Commonwealth countries².
