**Talk about the past**

There's only one past tense in English

**→ the simple past**

Regular verbs: base verb + -ed (it's the rule)

Some verbs can be irregular in the past tense.

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- 1) Aiden wanted to work near Trinity College.
- 2) Fiona lived in Connemara as a child and visited Dublin with her grannie.
- 3) Aiden studied Old Irish because he loved the Book of Kells.
- 4) Fiona learnt Irish with her grandmother.
- 5) Josh was 5 when he started skating.

**Word order**

**Active voice** → S + BV + -ed + object

**Passive voice** → S + was/were + past participle

- 1) The Book of Kells was created by monks at the Abbey of Saint Columba.

- 3) It was made in Scotland, on the island of Iona.
