There's only one past tense in English

→ the simple past

Regular verbs: base verb + -ed (it's the rule)

Some verbs can be irregular in the past tense.

- 3) Aiden studied Old Irish because he loved the Book of Kells.

Active voice → S + BV + -ed + object

Passive voice → S + was/were + past

participle


