

Mavis has got a mother-in-law. <u>Her</u> name is Linda. Mavis is Linda's daughter-in-law.

Linda has got a son. <u>His</u> name is Jonathan. Linda is Jonathan's mother.

Jonathan has got a wife. <u>Her</u> name is Mavis. Jonathan is Mavis's husband.

#### **HAVE GOT = HAVE**

#### Forme affirmative au présent :

I have got
You have got
He, she, it has got
We have got
You have got
They have got

#### Forme négative :

I haven't got your keys.

#### Forme interrogative:

Have you got a sister?






