

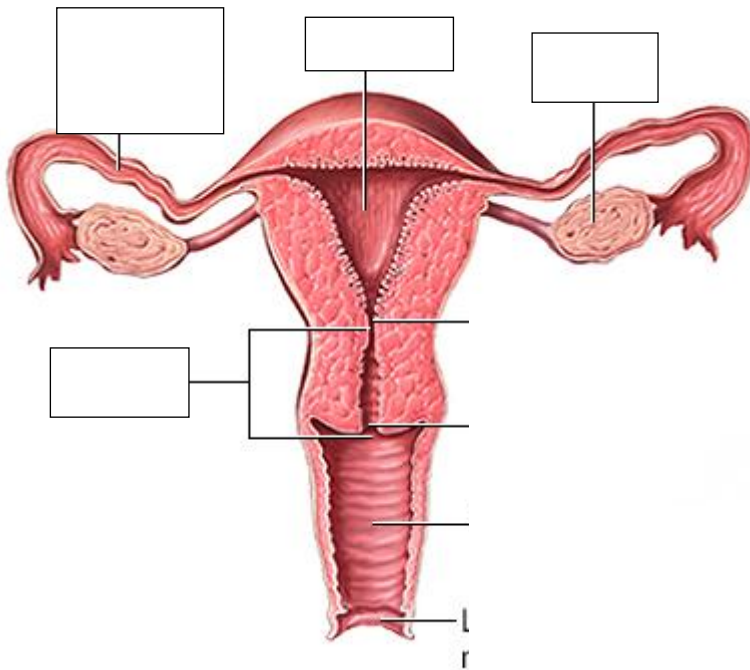

<input type="checkbox"/> Ovaries	<input type="checkbox"/> a pair of tubes running from the ovary to the uterus, through which an egg cell travels.
<input type="checkbox"/> Uterus	<input type="checkbox"/> the outer folds that surround the openings of the vagina and the opening from the bladder called the urethra.
<input type="checkbox"/> Fallopian tubes	<input type="checkbox"/> two organs on either side of the lower abdomen that release an egg cell monthly.
<input type="checkbox"/> Vagina	<input type="checkbox"/> an organ, also called the womb, where the fertilized egg cell implants and grows into the unborn baby.
<input type="checkbox"/> Vulva	<input type="checkbox"/> a muscular tube that receives the penis during sex, through which sperm travel on their way to fertilize the egg.
